## C. COOKIE POLICY

### 1. WHAT ARE COOKIES?

## 5. PERFORMANCE COOKIES/TECHNOLOGIES

These enable us to collect information about how you use our websites or read our publications, for instance which pages are viewed by visitors most frequently. All information collected in this way is used to improve how our websites work or its effectiveness.
